<b>Treatment Works:</b>	The facility consist of a headworks, including bar screens, grit removal and influent flow measurements via a 9-inch Parshall flume equipped with ultrasonic meter, followed by chemical addition (sodium aluminate) for phosphorus removal, three aeration basins in series, two final clarifier, two sand filters, ultraviolet disinfection, and effluent flow measurement via a 9-inch Parshall flume equipped with ultrasonic meter.

<b>Compliance Schedules</b>	<p>a. A compliance schedule to give the facility time to in- stall the appropriate temperature monitoring equipment and begin gathering information</p> <p>b. A timeframe of two years has been established to meet this requirement.</p> <p>c. A compliance schedule to give the facility time to in- stall any necessary construction or additional treatment to meet newly established T.I.N. limitations. A timeframe of five and a half years has been established to meet this re- quirement. If the limitations can be met with the current treatment process, no construction is required.</p>

<b>Control Regulation #74</b>	Because the discharge from this facility ultimately impacts Bear Creek Reservoir, it is subject to the Bear Creek Control Regulation, Regulation 74. This regulation imposes a total phosphorus concentration limitation of 1.0 mg/l on all dischargers in the watershed. In addition, the regulation specifies a mass limitation for dischargers of record.
